YOUR WETiZ-BOARD | CARE & MAINTENANCE

Built for the water and designed to last – a little care goes a long way.

USING YOUR BOARD

Your board is designed for performance in demanding conditions. A few simple checks help keep it ready every time you head out.

- Before entering the water, make sure the air vent screw is securely tightened.
- When your board is not in use, remove the air vent screw to allow proper air circulation inside the board. Never leave the air vent screw in the board on warm or hot days, as expanding air may create excessive pressure on the board's structure.

REGULAR CHECK-UPS

Small checks before each session help avoid bigger issues later.

- Before use, check that the fin and handles are securely fastened and in good condition.
- Inspect your board regularly for cracks, dents, or other damage that could allow water to enter.
- If damage is found, do not use the board in the water. Rinse the affected area with fresh water, allow it to dry completely, and arrange for professional repair.

STORING YOUR BOARD

Proper storage protects both performance and appearance over time.

- Prolonged exposure to UV radiation can damage the board's structure, fade colors, shrink knee pads, or make handles brittle.
- Store your board in a board bag or a shaded, protected area whenever possible. Always ensure the board is completely dry before storage.
- Store your board on padded racks and keep it off the ground to prevent scratches to the hull.
- After every session, rinse your board thoroughly with fresh water to remove salt and debris.

TRANSPORTING YOUR BOARD

Safe transport helps protect your equipment on the way to and from the water.

- When transporting your board on a roof rack, make sure it is securely fastened. Avoid overtightening the straps, as this may cause damage.
- Use suitable, high-quality tie-down straps to minimize the risk of damage and ensure safe transport.
